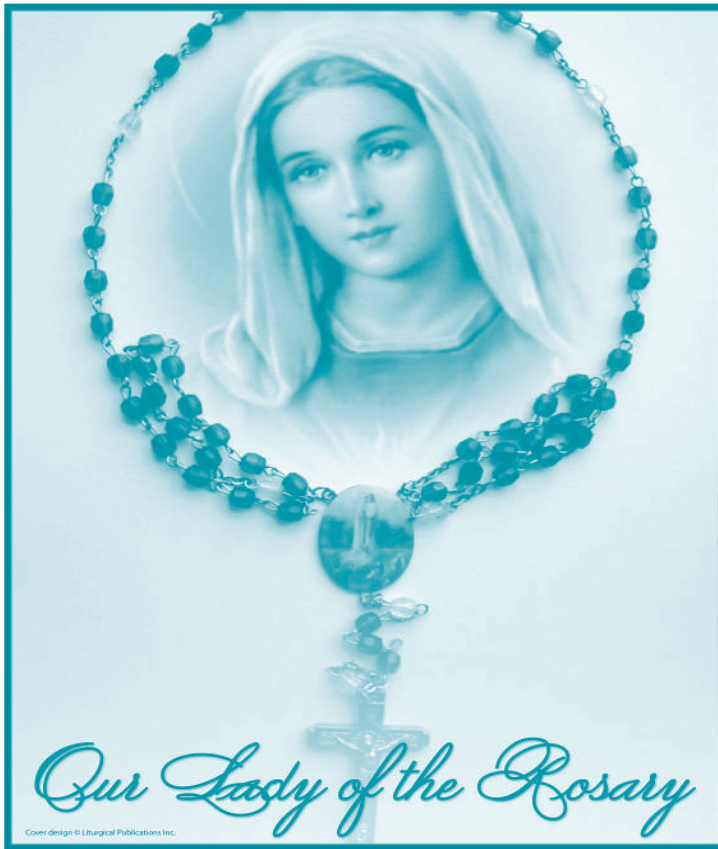

SCHOOL YEAR NEWS 2014-2015

Peeking into ...Grade 3!

I am thrilled with the progress we are making in 3rd Grade. The students have adjusted well to the schedule, routine, and work very well. Each student is working on their first writing assignment titled "What I Like About Autumn". There is so much to love about this season and their writing reflects that. In Math, we are strengthening our facts and fluency in addition and subtraction with games, write on boards, and partner work. Each child should be completing the X-tra Math program each night to help with skill building and math bags will be sent home with students soon. Each bag contains a math game to play with a partner or alone to assist with learning. In Science, we are exploring life cycles and what organisms need to survive. The geography of the Earth and landforms is our focus in Social Studies. They are learning about the 5 regions of the U.S. and how people adapt to living in these different regions. For Religion, we are focusing on the Sacraments of Christian Initiation. The students are also learning the prayers and responses we say in Mass each week. I am thankful for each of your children and enjoy every day we spend together. Third grade is a great place to be !
