SCHOOL YEAR NEWS 2014-2015

We really enjoyed the celebration with our Grandparents. The grandparents seemed very excited to see the children's performances and see their grandchildren's teachers & classmates.

Parent/teacher conferences were also held this week. We were happy to have the chance to meet with each student's parents. It's hard to believe the first quarter marking period is finished!

Peeking into ...Grade 6!

In Social Studies, the 6th grade class is being introduced to the timeline in the campaign process for the NH General Elections. They have written weekly current events, had a guest speaker from the Massachusetts House of Representatives and all experienced visiting a campaign headquarters of a candidate they have researched. The 6th grade ran a school-wide election to vote for Governor, Congress and Senate. Our sixth graders know more about the candidates than lots of adults! They are now working on the Decimal Place Value system in math and reviewing the 4 operations, changing decimals to fractions and percents. By relating this to calculating our popular and electoral votes in the election, the students are learning why they need to master these math concepts. After the initial shock of seeing what an owl pellet looks like, the students are almost finished dissecting their pellet in their Science Ecology unit. It has been quite a challenge finding every bone and matching up the types/shapes to give a hypothesis on the animal their owl captured. Mrs. Leshinski
