# CANDLEMAS



Candlemas is also the purification of Mary or the Presentation of our Lord (40 days after Christmas) February 2, 2015

When Christ was presented in the temple, "there was a man in Jerusalem named Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel" (Luke 2:25)

When Mary and Joseph brought Christ to the temple, Simeon embraced the Child and prayed the Cantic of Simeon: "Now thou dost dismiss thy servant, O Lord, according to the word in peace; because my eyes have seen thy salvation, which thou hast prepared before the face of all peoples: a light to revelation of the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel" (Luke 2:29-32)

Inspired the words of the cantic ("a light to the revelation of the Gentiles"), by the 11th century, the custom had developed in the West of blessing candles on the Feast of the Presentation, Candlemas.

A nice tradition is for each member of the family or a family as a whole to receive a candle to be lit on birthdays, baptismal anniversaries, first Holy Communion, and in sickness.

#### **Peeking into... Grade 1**

First grade is a busy, busy, place! The students have been studying motion, gravity and magnets. The classroom has come alive as we tested the force of gravity and figured out ways to stop an object in motion. The students worked together to create simple machines from string, straws and popsicle sticks that were used to push and pull a block. We discovered the magnetic forces ability to attract and repel. It was exciting to watch the children question, hypothesize and test their understanding! The Children's reading and writing skills are increasing by leaps and bounds. They love to spend times working with their book boxes and writing in their journals. In religion, we are working hard at practicing love for one another and God. 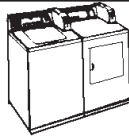
