### **PEEKING INTO: GRADE 5**

The fifth graders recently finished reading The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe by C.S. Lewis. They learned about character, setting and events as well as discovering the deeper meaning of the story about our Catholic Faith and beliefs.

C.S.Lewis wrote the Narnia series in order to teach children about the Bible and their faith. In the book, the students witness Aslan, The "Great Lion", exchange his life in order to save Edmund. Aslan, rising from the dead in order to save Narnia, is a presentation of Jesus' death and resurrection. The fifth graders practiced writing summaries about the events that happened in each chapter. In Science, the students did a wonderful job with their science fair projects, and each student presented his/her project to the class. Our May field trips will be to Lowell to learn about the canal system and the cotton mills, and to Strawberry Banke to learn about archaeology and New England life through the centuries.

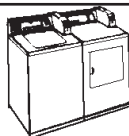
