After the Rosary we will gather in the church hall for light refreshments and a brief presentation about the "Silver Rose".

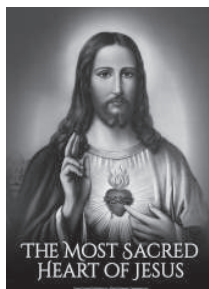
We will then view a short DVD about Our Lady of Guadalupe- "The Blood and the Rose"

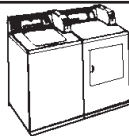
