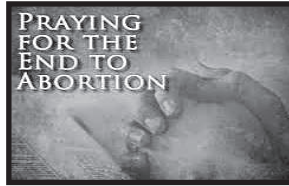

The abortionist from Vermont arrived shortly after the abortionist from



Massachusetts, so the prayer volunteers and sidewalk counselors anticipated a busy day. They were happy to be proven wrong. The missionary image of Our Lady of Guadalupe (patroness of the unborn) was outside Planned Parenthood from 10am to noon, which could explain why there were fewer abortions performed than normal.

During the day, a man told the volunteers he and his female companion were there for STD testing. That proved to be untrue several hours later as he helped her walk to the car post-abortion.

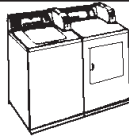
