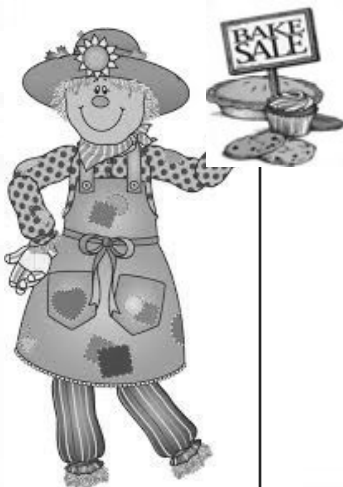
Has ended for the summer. Please continue to watch the bulletin for information on when we will resume. Thank you and enjoy the rest of the summer.

WEDNESDAYS ON PENNACOOK STREET

The prayer vigil outside Planned Parenthood has changed from Thursdays to Wednesdays, which is when surgical abortions are now taking place. Although sidewalk counselors and prayer volunteers remain focused on the surgical abortions performed, please keep in mind that chemical abortions (the RU486 pill) are available most days. It is important to have people on the sidewalk to offer information about the abortion pill reversal procedure (cards provided by the Pennacook pregnancy Center). Reversal is possible up to 72 hours after ingestion of the first dose. 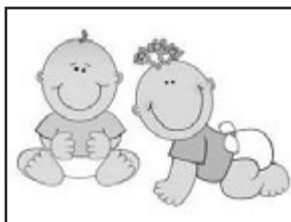
