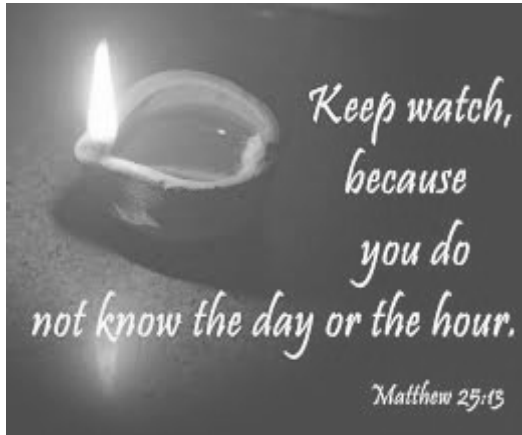

WEDNESDAYS ON PENNACOOK ST.

Three women praying during 40 Days For Life reported they had a chance to speak with several couples going into Planned Parenthood. One young couple said they were there for a pregnancy test, but decided to walk up to the Pennacook Pregnancy Center for a free test after it was suggested to them. Another couple said they were there for a pill abortion. They went inside but left a short time later, and said they changed their minds. They were told about the local pregnancy centers that would help them throughout the pregnancy. People praying and offering information every day makes a difference! Manchester's PP now offers pill abortions/chemical abortions some weeks Monday through Friday, with surgical abortions scheduled on Wednesdays.
