School News 2017-2018

PEEKING INTO GRADE 5

The fifth graders have been very busy since school started. They have learned about characters, setting, problem, events, and solution in the stories they have read. They have also worked on writing summaries for the stories as well. In writing, the students wrote poems about the fall or school. They wrote personal narratives about what they had done on their summer vacations. They are currently working using descriptive writing in their stories. The students also learned about the parts of speech, capitalization rules, punctuation rules, and types of sentences.

In science, the fifth graders learned how changing variables could produce different results by experimenting with growing mold on bread in different conditions.

They tested growing mold by adding more water



to the bread. The students were able to grow lots of mold. They loved this “gross” experiment! They have also been learning about space and observing the moon and the stars at night and created a Venn diagram comparing the moon and the Earth. They are now learning about “What’s out there” in our solar system, in our galaxy, and in the universe. These are just some of the many things that the fifth graders have been busy doing since school started!

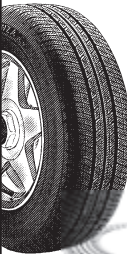
