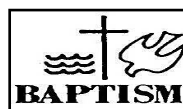

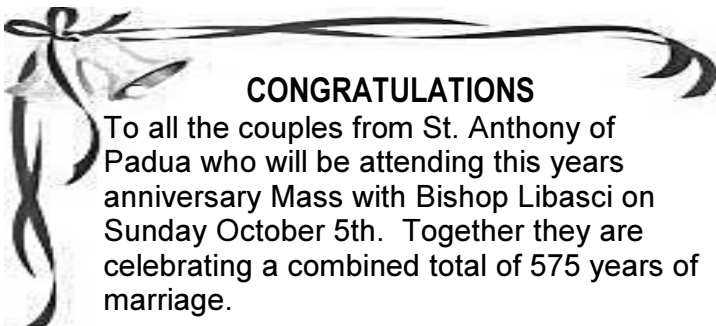
Included: a Great late lunch at the Chateau Restaurant. Beginning with a fresh salad, homemade bread and beverages. There are three entrée choices:
