**Peeking into: Grade 6**

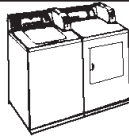
The 6<sup>th</sup> grade is now exploring the world of protists and fungi. They are learning how these microscopic creatures live in their own world. The students have been collecting samples of pond water and will observe their habits, movements and characteristics under the microscope. There have been some interesting discussions of “good and bad” fungus in our lives and the benefits of both. We are in the middle of our unit on fractions. What a difference a year makes!!! The 6th graders have definitely become experts with the operations of fractions. Our next step is for the students to be able to shop at the mall and figure out, using per cents, what their marked down summer clothes will cost. Our class will have 2 great field trips during May. We will travel to Lowell Mills and do an Ecology hands-on science lab. The students will learn about pollution and cleanup of the Merrimack River, stressing the importance of our water supply. At the end of May, we will summarize our unit on Oceanography by visiting the Seacoast Science Center in Rye, NH. We will explore the salt marshes, spend a few hours tide pooling for ocean creatures along our coast, then finish with a Scavenger Hunt to Sandy Beach. We will end our school year with a retreat, then Mass and promotion ceremony.
