WHAT IS THE NICKELS FOR NEIGHBORS PROGRAM?

It is a program that started here at St. Anthony's Parish with the children in the CCD program about ten years ago. When a child attends CCD classes, he or she is encouraged to make a small donation or tithing of a nickel or more to help feed the poor. Their donation is given to the St. Vincent de Paul Society so they in turn can buy food to feed the hungry.

Over the last ten years the CCD Nickels for Neighbors have collected and donated \$3512.44 to the St. Vincent de Paul Society in our parish. The children's donations teach them to share with those who are less fortunate as they grow into young adults. It also shows them no matter how much you donate, it adds up, and teaches them pride that they helped others in need.
