### Peeking into Religion - Grades 4, 5 & 6

October has also been a busy month for the 4<sup>th</sup> graders, focusing on the Communion of Saints. St. Anthony of Padua, St. Therese of Lisieux, St. John the Evangelist, St. Rose of Lima, St. Peter, St. Paul, St. Mark, St. Mary, the Blessed Virgin, St. Joseph, St. Anne, St. George, St. Cecilia, St. Julia, St. Lucy, St. John the Baptist and St. Elizabeth Seton were our companions the last couple of weeks. Posters and puppets were created and decorate our school walls.
