ST ANTHONY OF PADUA DEVOTION

For those who have a special affection for St. Anthony of Padua, known to be a great miracle worker, the devotions are a unique way for special intentions, every Tuesday, immediately following the 8AM Mass, to venerate his relic and ask for this intercession. In 1937, Fr. Paul Desaulniers, fourth pastor of St. Anthony Parish, included the Thirteen Tuesdays of St. Anthony in his revamped parish timetable. This devotion, *then* scheduled for every Tuesday at 7PM, included prayers, a teaching, Benediction and veneration of the relic of St. Anthony. It would appear that the ritual, in some form, has continued for all these years although there is no longer reference to "thirteen Tuesdays".
