ST ANTHONY OF PADUA DEVOTION

For those who have a special affection for St. Anthony of Padua, known to be a great miracle worker, the devotions are a unique way for special intentions, every Tuesday, immediately following the 8AM Mass, to venerate his relic and ask for this intercession. In 1937, Fr. Paul Desaulniers, fourth pastor of St. Anthony Parish, included the Thirteen Tuesdays of St. Anthony in his revamped parish timetable. This devotion, *then* scheduled for every Tuesday at 7PM, included prayers, a teaching, Benediction and veneration of the relic of St. Anthony. It would appear that the ritual, in some form, has continued for all these years although there is no longer reference to "thirteen Tuesdays".


WEDNESDAYS ON PENNACOOK STREET

Wednesday it was abortions as usual and prayer volunteers were on the sidewalk to offer help to any who would brave the cold and stop to talk or take a brochure. The police officer stayed in his truck and the volunteer escort stayed inside Planned Parenthood and only went outside when a car drove into the parking lot. Surgical abortions are scheduled for Wednesdays, but appointments for chemical/medical abortions are done most weekdays. Chemical/medical (RU486) abortions can be reversed within 72 hours of taking the first dose – but before taking the second dose. This is your opportunity to save a baby and help a mother who changes her mind after taking the first dose. PEEKING INTO GRADE 2

Second grade has been working hard as 2018 arrives! The students have been busy learning the steps of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Each child has been able to memorize the Act of Contrition and they know the importance of being sorry and asking God for forgiveness through the sacrament.
